Our school strategies are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2015, we have focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our *Great Results Guarantee* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our strategies to ensure that every student succeeds.

Strategies implemented include:

- Provide intensive support across the early years to improve the literacy and numeracy results for all students.
- Provide every class with appropriate resources and infrastructure to achieve agreed goals.
- Provide appropriate ICT infrastructure to support learning programs including assistive technology to support students with disabilities.
- Analyze and interpret a range of data including PAT Maths, Fountas and Pinnell reading assessment and report card data to measure growth and inform future directions.
- Utilize Teacher aides to provide small group intensive and targeted teaching to improve identified students results in literacy and numeracy. Provide training and ongoing support to teacher aides in the delivery and implementation of these programs

After reviewing our *Great Results Guarantee* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our strategies as needed to ensure every student succeeds.
